

Mixed Recycling Guidelines:

Mixed recycling refers to putting all recyclables in one bin. No need to separate recyclables anymore!

What types of materials **can** be put in the mixed recycling bin?

- All mixed paper including newspaper, magazines, catalogs, brown paper bags, paper packaging, beverage cartons, all office paper, phone books, envelopes, junk mail.
- All plastics containers including beverage and food containers, detergent bottles, household cleaners, yogurt cups, rigid plastic containers such as pipette trays.
- All glass containers including all beverage and food containers.
- All cardboard
- Metal: Aluminum cans, aluminum pans, foil

What **CANNOT** be recycled in the mixed recycling bin?

- No trash
- No food waste or food soiled containers
- No Styrofoam
- No broken china
- No corks
- No soiled paper
- No hazardous waste
